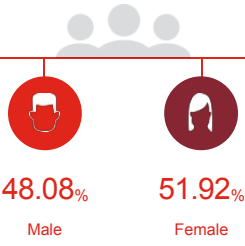

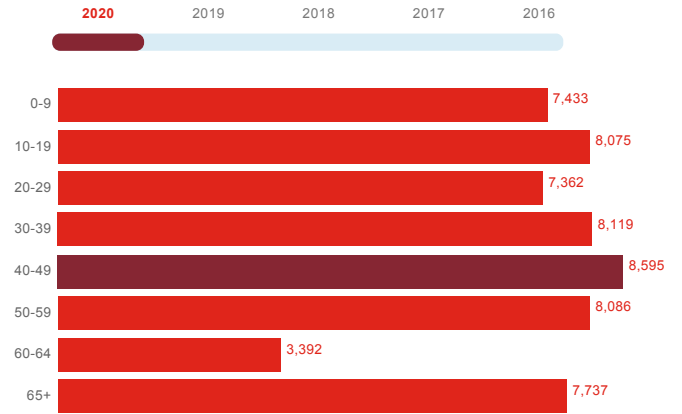
The total population of Union County is 60,620. The median age is 37.24

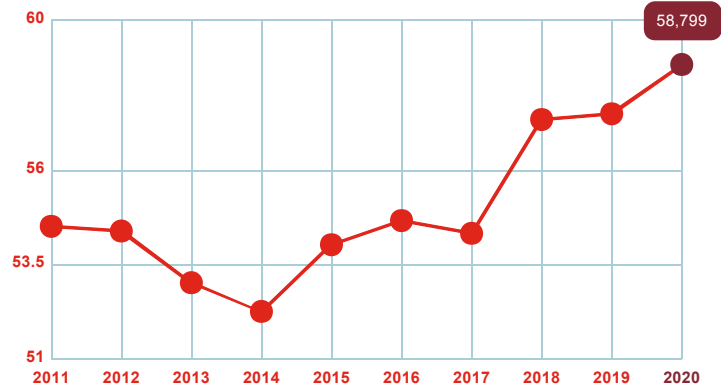
Age Distribution



Median Age

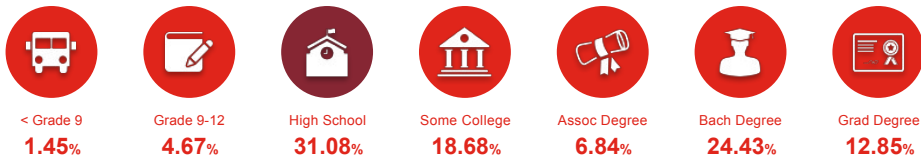

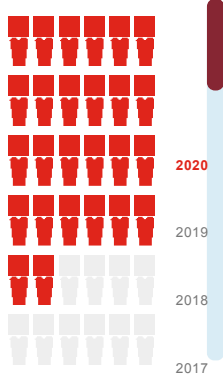

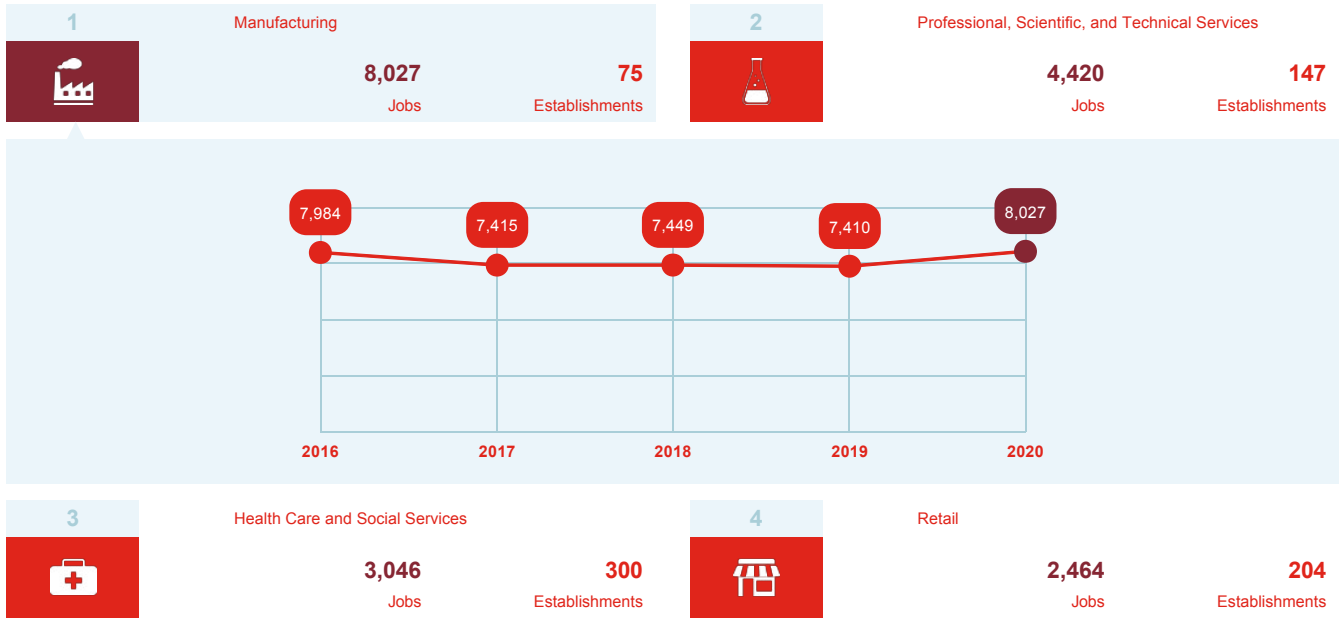

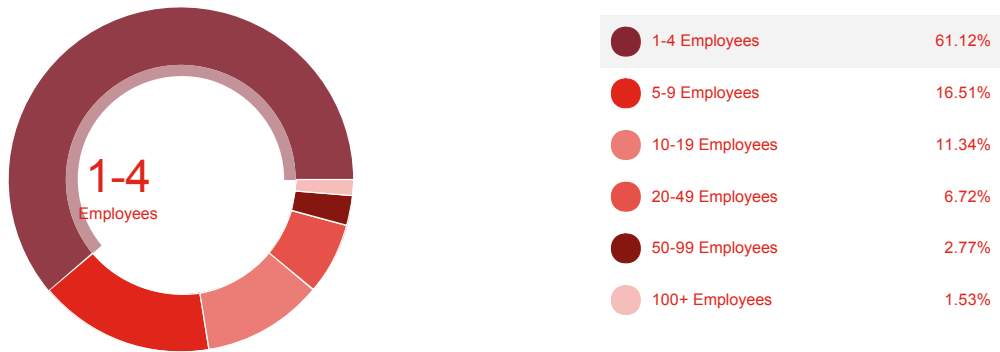
Businesses and Jobs

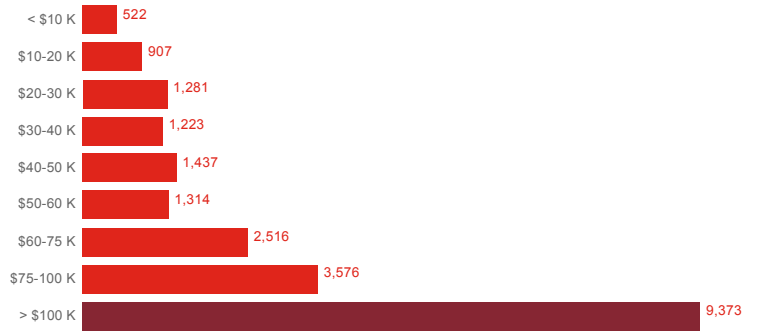

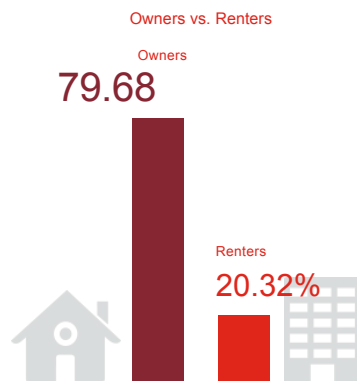
